THE 5TH ANNUAL CAUSEWAY 5K IS COMING TO MANAHAWKIN

The event, presented by **Causeway Family of Dealerships** and Causeway CARes, will be held at Southern Regional High School on October 16th.

TOMS RIVER, NJ – It's almost time to lace up those sneakers and support a great cause! The 5th Annual Causeway 5K will be held on Sunday, October 16th at Southern Regional High School, 90 Cedar Bridge Road in Manahawkin. The event, presented by Causeway Family of Dealerships and Causeway CARes, starts at 8:45am (walkers) and 9am (5K) and all proceeds will benefit Fulfill and Family Promise of Southern Ocean County.

The flat and fast course is chip timed. The day will feature overall and age group awards, as well as door prizes. T-shirts are guaranteed to the first 250 registrants.

The cost to walk or run is \$40 through September 30th, and \$45 after September 30th and on race day. Students (18 years old and under) can receive \$10 off by using the promo code: STUDENT. All registrations must be completed online at www.raceforum.com/CAUSEWAY. There will be no paper copies on race day. Participants will receive a confirmation email with a bib number to bring to the event.

"We carefully selected Fulfill and Family Promise of Southern Ocean County this year's 5K beneficiaries because both organizations are on a mission to battle hunger and homelessness in

Ocean County, which is something that Causeway cares deeply about," said David C. Wintrode, President of Causeway Family of Dealerships/ Causeway CARes. "The demand for food at the Jersey Shore is up 60 percent so far this year, according to Fulfill. We need to do our part to bring this statistic down."

Fulfill has been a 5K beneficiary since the race's inception five years ago. The nonprofit's mission is to alleviate hunger and build food security in Monmouth and Ocean Counties and make sure that all people at all times have access to enough nutritious food to maintain an active and healthy life.

This year, Family Promise of Southern Ocean County was also selected as a 5K beneficiary. Its mission is to partner with communities to guide homeless children and their families toward achieving sustainable independence.

Last year, the 4th Annual Causeway 5K raised over \$40.250 and saw a 50 percent increase in runners/walkers from the prior year.

CHILDREN AND FAMILIES ARE GIVEN THE OPPORTUNITY TO **ENGAGE WITH THE ARTS**

The Community Arts and Music Programs (CAMP) is one of the many programs at the Jay and Linda Grunin Center for the Arts that has helped transform arts engagement in Ocean County.

TOMS RIVER, NJ – "The coolest thing just happened in this room... and everybody saw it," said the Amazing Max Darwin. "If you [the audience] just saw a beautiful young lady floating in the air, please raise your hand [hands go up all around the theatre]. You were FLOATING [pointing to Catherine]. Look... everybody saw it. So now your name is not Catherine. You are Catherine the floating girl."

With her eyes wide and mind bewildered, Catherine was in awe that she was part of something that could only be described as one thing – magical. It was a moment that she will remember forever.

Experiences like this happen regularly at the Jay and Linda Grunin Center for the Arts at Ocean County College.

The Amazing Max was a part of the 2022 Community Arts and Music Programs (CAMP) available at Grunin Center over the summer months.

CAMP was started in 2017 after David C. Wintrode, President of Causeway Family of Dealerships/Causeway CARes, had an idea to create a series of performances for the community that would focus on things that are really fun, but also educational.

"Many children never have the opportunity to see live shows," said Wintrode. "These programs would give school-aged children and individuals with special needs the opportunity to engage with the arts."

Heidi M. Sheridan, Interim Executive and Artistic Director for the Jay and Linda Grunin Center for the Arts, also notes that many places are eliminating music and arts from their programming. "We are stepping into make sure that children have these collective, shared experiences," she said. "We really want children to feel like anything is possible."

"This year, thanks to the generous support of the Wintrode Family Foundation and the Ocean County College Foundation, we hosted five artists for CAMP performances," said Jaclyn Wood, Assitant Director, Education & Community Engagement at the Jay and Linda Grunin Center for the Arts. "All the CAMP events were fully funded by these organizations and free for attendees."

When it comes to selecting entertainers, it is a collaborative effort. "I will talk to different agents and artists and even see them perform," said Wood. "I am looking for artists who are not just good at what they do, but they give these children an experience they will never forget."

Once Wood has a list of vetted performers, Mr. Wintrode, alongside a committee, will select the talent.

This year's programming included Jeff Boyer's Big Bubble Bonanza, Doktor Kaboom's Look Out- Science is Coming!, Twinkle Time, The Amazing Max and Christopher Agostino's Storyfaces.

"The CAMP series has a lot of heart because it started in a very pure way," said Wood. "The goal has always been to give kids the opportunity to be more involved with the arts."

This summer, the CAMP series saw 2,880 attendees with both The Amazing Max and Storyfaces being filled to capacity.

and in the Grunin Center season brochure. In addition to camps and community groups, families and homeschool groups came to performances.

"We were pleased to welcome back groups who had attended these performances in the past, as well as some new groups," Wood added.

Past participants who were in attendance this year included: Ocean County YMCA, YMCA Camp Zehnder, Point Pleasant Recreation, Little Egg Harbor's Summer Splash, Lacey Schools Extended School Year (ESY) Program and Prime Time Center. New groups included: Red Bank YMCA, Freehold YMCA, Innovate Kids Club, My Jacob's Ladder and Community Options.

Groups were extremely excited to be back, but perhaps the biggest challenge this year was getting them to the venue.

"Transportation was often an issue, with groups not having the funding to pay for a bus to bring them to the Grunin Center, but this year was especially challenging because of a bus driver shortage," said Wood.

That's when the Wintrode Family Foundation and the Ocean County College Foundation stepped in to help.

"Thanks to additional support from these organizations, we were able to bring 756 campers and camp leaders to the shows who wouldn't have been able to attend otherwise by booking charter buses to transport them," said Wood. "I am so thankful for the support of these two organizations because without them these programs would not be possible."

Looking back, perhaps the best part of the CAMP series is watching kids come into the lobby and you can see that they are just so excited to be there, according to Wood. "Everyone feels a sense of wonder and that anything is possible," she said. "You can come here and have an experience that you will remember for the rest of your life."

Dorothy Quincy and her wealthy fiancé, John Hancock, were in Massachusetts in April 1775, when the "shot heard 'round the world" was fired. Newly wed in 1776, she was his unofficial secretary when John signed the Declaration of Independence in Philadelphia. Two years later, the Bread Riots of France threatened the delicate

French Alliance until Dorothy's valuable diplomatic skills rescued the pact in Boston. She carried on and amassed many of the most fascinating tales of the war with England.

Actor-singer-dancer-costumer Kim Hanley has re-created historical figures in the White House Visitors Center, National Archives, National Portrait Gallery, Mount Rushmore, and dozens of sites in New York, Philadelphia, Delaware, Pennsylvania, and Washington, DC.



The golfers had no idea a #1 draft pick, a Heisman trophy winner, two Super Bowl champions, and a Hall of Famer NFL player were going to be on the course. That is who they saw when





RICOTTA COOKIES

Ingredients for Cookies:

1 3/4 cup sugar

15 ounces of Ricotta cheese – over allow

2 tablespoons vanilla extract 4 cups all-purpose flour, sifted

1 teaspoon baking soda

1 teaspoon baking powder Orange zest from half an orange, plus 4 teaspoons of orange juice

Ingredients for Icing:

5 tablespoons of whole milk 1 ½ cups confectioners' sugar

1 teaspoon almond extract Orange zest from half an orange

Preheat oven to 350 degrees. Combine all cookie ingredients together until well mixed. Spoon about 2-3 tablespoons of cookie dough and form into balls of dough. Leave about 3 inches of spacing between cookies when placing them on the cookie sheet. Baker's tip: use parchment paper to prevent cookies from sticking and for easy clean up! Bake at 350 degrees for 15-20 minutes, until golden brown.

While the cookies are baking, combine all ingredients for icing and mix until light and fluffy. Once cookies are fully cooled, decorate with the icing and add sprinkles or your favorite



TEEN SAVED ELDERLY NEIGHBOR'S LIFE, HONORED BY STAFFORD TOWNSHIP

STAFFORD, NJ — A teenage Stafford resident was honored by the Township Council and police department for the actions he took to save his elderly neighbor's life.

Nicholas Pulizzano, 19, was honored through a proclamation at a recent council meeting.

On Aug. 7, Pulizzano was outside when he heard faint cries for help, Mayor Greg Myhre said.

He immediately began looking for the caller and found

his elderly neighbor who had fallen and was "extremely dehydrated and delirious," Myhre said. She was in immediate need of emergency medical care, he said.

Pulizzano swiftly contacted Stafford EMS, and his neighbor was taken to Southern Ocean Medical Center, where she received the lifesaving care she needed, Myhre

"He really took action where a lot of people might have just gone about their day or said 'none of my business,"" Myhre said. "Thanks to you, a woman is alive."

"I believe you saved that woman's life, so you can have that with you for the rest of your life," Police Chief Thomas Dellane said.

Officer Anthony Vincent echoed the same thoughts. "There's not many 19-year-olds in Stafford Township who have that sense of awareness and alertness to follow a faint cry for help," he said.

"He knew that cry for help was somebody that was in dire need," Vincent said.

Vincent also thanked Pulizzano's father for breaking down the back door to get to the woman.

For his actions, Pulizzano was presented with a Stafford Township Police Department command citation.

According to 6abc.com, this question does not have one answer because there are a few different scenarios.

Be advised that you must stop at least 25 feet away from a school bus in New Jersey to be following the

According to 6abc.com, if you are driving on, "a twolane roadway, vehicles traveling in both directions must come to a complete stop." So whether you are

behind the school bus or driving in the opposite direction: STOP.

If you are driving on, "a multi-lane roadway without a median separation or one with a center



turning lane, vehicles traveling in both directions must stop," according to 6abc.com. Basically, STOP no matter which side you are on.

According to 6abc.com, if you are driving on a, "multilane roadway divided by a barrier or a median, vehicles traveling in the same direction of the school bus, either in the same lane behind the bus or in an adjacent lane must come to a complete stop."

"If you are traveling on the opposite side of the roadway as the school bus, proceed with caution," but you do not have to come to a full stop. So if you are on the same side as the bus, STOP.

New Jersey does not mess when it comes to the safety of our school goers.

According to 6abc.com, if you choose to ignore these rules, you could, "face fines of at least \$100, 15 days in jail or 15 days of community service or both," for the first offense.

For subsequent offenses, drives will be fined, "at least \$250 and 15 days in jail." It will also come with 5 points being added to your license.

Whenever in doubt, just stop for a school bus if their red stop sign is extended.




