

What started as a small garden at our Neptune Headquarters in 2000 has flourished into a full Garden Education Program, teaching children and adults how to grow, harvest and prepare fresh produce for healthier, more self-sustaining



At Fulfill, we understand that hunger isn't solved just by feeding people. That's why we take a comprehensive approach to hunger by offering programs, services and resources that address the root causes of food insecurity. Through the Garden Education Program, we're empowering neighbors with the knowledge and tools to grow their own food and build a more secure future.

The Garden Education Program includes five unique initiatives that engage all ages and populations through hands-on learning and sustainable growing practices. With the guidance of Garden Coordinators like Kendal McGackin, our gardens have become spaces for learning and shared purpose. "We see the garden as a classroom, a food source and a community hub," says Kendal. "When someone learns to grow their own food, they're not just feeding themselves for a season, they're building lifelong skills."

Learning Garden

The Learning Garden, located onsite at our Neptune Headquarters, grows a variety of fresh produce, from tomatoes and cucumbers to kale, figs, fruit and fresh herbs, on a quarter-acre of land. Produce is harvested and distributed directly to the community or through our network of pantry partners.

Plant beds, a fruit orchard, a heated greenhouse, a cold frame for protection against adverse weather, a five-bin compost system, eight honeybee colonies, mushroom growing area and an Eagle Scout-built wash station are all managed by our full-time garden employees and volunteers.

Giving Garden Network

Across Monmouth and Ocean Counties, 30 community gardens put fresh, locally grown produce in food pantries. Each garden is paired with a nearby pantry, creating a direct pipeline from harvest to pantry to table. During the last growing season, the Network proudly produced 26,492 pounds of fresh fruits and vegetables.

Seed to Supper

This 10-week adult education workshop is designed for beginners interested in learning how to grow their







own food on a budget, combining classroom instruction with garden-based learning. Participants learn urban farming techniques, including soil preparation, composting, planting, watering and harvesting. The program helps individuals build confidence in growing food, regardless of prior experience.

After completing the workshop series, each participant is assigned a garden bed at our Community Garden and encouraged to plant and maintain crops of their choice. Seed to Supper encourages participants to be self-sufficient and make healthy, cost-effective meals at

School Garden Network

We're planting the seeds of knowledge early, because knowing where food comes from and why nutrition matters can spark a lifelong healthy habit. This eightweek workshop teaches students in K-8th grades the fundamentals of gardening, how to build garden beds, grow their own produce and even prepare meals using the fruits and vegetables that they grew themselves. "Students will try new foods when they are the ones to nurture it to full harvest," explains Kendal.

We also provide schools with a garden curriculum to integrate garden-based learning into the classroom giving teachers the tools to continue the work after the workshops end.

Growing Skills and Opportunities at Field of Dreams

Through our partnership with RWJBarnabas Health's Field of Dreams, we offer year-round job training for

neurodiverse adults. Participants play an active role in tending the sports complex's garden and aquaponics farm while also receiving hands-on instruction in nutrition, cooking and garden planning. These experiences help individuals build transferable skills that prepare them for meaningful employment opportunities.

From young students learning where their meals come from to adults gaining the skills to grow their own food, each program plants seeds of knowledge, empowerment and resilience. "We're growing more than crops; we're cultivating community and building a healthier, more food-secure future for Monmouth and Ocean Counties residents," said Kendal.

As the state moves forward with road improvements around Fulfill, it won't take away from the garden's charm or its role as a source of hope and nourishment.

There's a place for everyone in our garden – whether you want to get hands-on by participating in our programs or support our efforts through donations of funds or gardening materials. FORD RECEIVES MOST **HONORS OF ANY BRAND IN 2025 J.D. POWER INITIAL QUALITY STUDY**

Ford continues to demonstrate progress improving vehicle quality, according to the J.D. Power 2025 U.S.



Initial Quality Study of customers in their first 90 days of ownership.

The Ford F-150, F-Series Super Duty, Mustang and Escape were each named best in their segments for initial quality — the most honors of any brand.

"Customers expect new vehicles to make their lives easier, more fun, or both right from the first mile," said Josh Halliburton, executive director of quality at Ford Motor Company. "Four segment-topping finishers and overall improving vehicle quality scores for most nameplates show that while we have to remain laser-focused on earning the trust of our customers, we're headed in the right direction."

Overall, half of Ford's eligible vehicles placed in the top three of their respective segments. Lincoln quality improved for the second year in a row, up six places among all brands. Lincoln Nautilus improved from eighth in the segment to fourth, above the Midsize Premium SUV average.

8 SIGNS OF DEHYDRATION YOU SHOULDN'T IGNORE

Dehydration may seem like something that happens to extreme athletes or someone who has a gastrointestinal illness. But doctors say it is a very real risk for all adults over age 65.

As you get older, your sense of thirst is blunted, so you may not recognize your body's need for fluids, says Ardeshir Hashmi, M.D., Section Chief of the Center for Geriatric Medicine at Cleveland Clinic.

"On a warm or hot day, without even sensing it, you're losing a ton of fluid," he says. "In older adults, the same level of dehydration that normally triggers a thirst response may not. The thirst mechanism goes down drastically, especially after

Other factors also put older adults at higher risk. The body's ability to retain water in blood vessels decreases with age, so fluids are more easily depleted. If you suffer from diabetes or take diuretics, both can contribute to water loss.

What's more, older adults with urinary incontinence may intentionally reduce their fluid intake or take medications to try to avoid accidents. And those experiencing cognitive decline may get dehydrated simply because they forget to drink, says Hal Atkinson, M.D., a professor of geriatric medicine at the Wake Forest School of Medicine.

"The pressure to drop so dramatically that amount of dehydration required you get dizzy, fall and break a bone. for that sense of thirst to kick in is going to happen a lot later than when you were younger," Hashmi gets so low that your heart is unable explains.

> Even if you don't feel thirsty, older adults should drink throughout the day, he advises. Aim for at least 48 ounces of fluid (six 8-ounce glasses) a day – and more if you're physically active. Juices, sports drinks, noncaffeinated sodas and flavored waters or seltzers all count toward your fluid intake, Hashmi says. You can also boost your intake with foods containing a lot of water such as soups, watermelon and cucumber.

2. Dark urine

The more fluid in your body, the clearer your urine will be. Your urine should be "almost the same color as tap water if you're well hydrated," Hashmi says.

If your urine turns a dark yellow or brownish color, or if it has a stronger odor than normal, that's likely an early sign of dehydration, and you need to drink more water.

3. Dizziness or fainting

Although dizziness can be a symptom of many different conditions, it is a classic sign of dehydration, Atkinson says. When you're dehydrated, you don't have enough fluid in your blood vessels. You feel dizzy because "you're not getting as much blood flow to the

brain," he explains. You're most likely to feel dizzy when you sit up after lying down, or stand up from sitting. If the blood flow to your brain drops significantly, you may notice a darkness in front of your eyes, Hashmi says. That may be a sign you're about to pass out from dehydration.

4. Muscle cramps or weakness

Another sign of dehydration is a feeling of weakness in certain muscles or severe muscle cramps. The cramps can be caused by electrolyte imbalances and reduced blood flow to those muscles.

Cramps can happen while you're exercising, or you may wake up in the middle of the night with cramping in your calf muscles. "It can be severe enough that it won't let you sleep," Hashmi says.

5. Constipation or less frequent urination

Water helps flush toxins out of your body and keeps your digestive system running smoothly. If you're adequately hydrating, you should be urinating every two or three hours and having regular bowel movements, Hashmi says. "If you're not going to the bathroom the usual number of times, that can indicate a problem," he says.

6. Dry skin or lack of skin elasticity

Dehydration causes skin to be dry and look sunken in some areas, such as under your eyes. Your skin will also have less elasticity than normal. If you are caring for someone who is frail, one way to tell if they are getting dehydrated is to gently

pinch or press the skin on their arm. "When you touch their skin, it may not spring back as easily as before," Atkinson says. "It can be very pronounced."

7. Dry mouth

Dehydration also reduces saliva production. If you suspect someone is dehydrated, pay attention to the inside of their mouth, Atkinson says. "Their tongue should have a glisten to it," he says. "In extreme [dehydration] cases, you may notice sores in their mouth that go along with not having enough fluid."

8. Fatigue, headache or confusion

Low blood flow due to dehydration can cause a headache, tiredness and weakness. Or you may just feel a little less sharp than usual. If you're a caregiver for someone who seems confused, don't rule out dehydration as a cause, Hashmi says: "A lot of things can cause confusion; maybe Mom or Dad has an infection. But it could also be that they're getting dehydrated, and their blood pressure has dropped. Sometimes when we give them fluid, it's amazing what happens." aarp.com

WHAT 50-PLUS ADULTS NEED TO KNOW ABOUT RENEWING A DRIVER'S LICENSE

If renewing your driver's license seems like a ho-hum, routine chore, be prepared: It might be different this time. In many states, older drivers are required to go through more stringent procedures and testing than their younger highway counterparts. This can include proving you have road-worthy vision or making an in-person visit to the Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV). Also, as of May 7, 2025, you are required to have a Real ID, a new, enhanced driver's license if you want to take domestic flights without your passport.

Here's a rundown of what you need to know when renewing your driver's license as an older adult.

What you need to get a Real ID

Just like a normal driver's license, you can get a Real ID from your state DMV. To obtain it, you'll need to show documents proving your age and identity, Social Security number, and address. That typically means bringing a birth certificate or passport, a Social Security card or tax form such as a W-2, and two proofs of address. If you've married and changed your name, you'll need to show a marriage certificate.

Most states mark Real ID cards with a gold or black star in the top right corner. The IDs also include an encoded "machine readable zone" with a person's scannable information.

Do you really need a Real ID?

You'll need a REAL ID not only to access domestic flights but to enter certain federal facilities, such as military bases. If you show up for a domestic flight with just your regular old driver's license, you will not be allowed past security.

There are, however, alternatives you can use, including passports, passport cards, U.S. military IDs, an ID from the federal Trusted Traveler Program (such as a Global Entry card) and Real ID-compliant mobile driver's licenses (a digital version of a driver's license that is

digital wallet). Enhanced Drivers Licenses (EDL) are also acceptable alternatives. An EDL is a driver's license that provides proof of U.S. citizenship. Five states offer EDLs: Michigan, Minnesota, New York, Vermont and Washington.

Older adults often have added requirements

Special renewal requirements for older adults may seem like age bias, but there is a reason. Loosening the time between in-person renewal requirements was linked to increased crash rates among drivers aged 65-74 and higher injury rates for drivers aged 75-plus, a study published in

that requirement starts at 62; in Kansas, it's 65).

Most states require proof of adequate vision. Iowa drivers aged 70+ must demonstrate acceptable eyesight every time they renew their license. Younger drivers only do it when they renew in person. In Maryland, proof is required starting at age 40.

A road test may be part of the process. One state, Illinois, requires drivers to take a road test at age 75-plus. "The driving test was associated with lower insurance claim frequencies, especially in densely populated areas of Illinois,'

Renewal requirements for older drivers can vary from state to state. Some states, for example, require older drivers to renew their licenses more frequently than younger drivers. The Institute for Highway Safety (IIHS) maintains a list of requirements for every state on its

You might need to renew sooner. In Arizona, for example, drivers age 60 and over need to renew their license every five years, compared to every 12 years for the rest of the state's drivers. In Hawaii, drivers over 72 must renew every two years; the general population does it every eight years.

In-person might be mandatory. Many states, including California, Idaho, Louisiana, and Massachusetts, also require drivers age 70-plus to renew

up when you're trying to get your driver's license renewed. Study your state's driver handbook. Each state offers a driver's handbook that includes safety information and

updates on new laws. "You might need a lot of caffeine to read it," jokes William Van Tassel, Manager of Driver Training Programs for the American Automobile Association (AAA), "but it's a great way to stay current." Freshen up your skills (and maybe

even save money). If you want to improve your odds of renewing your license — not to mention protecting vourself, your passengers, and other drivers — it helps to refresh and maybe even improve your driving

skills. Here are some ways you can become a better driver and meet the renewal requirements.

Take a driving class (it might even save you money). AARP's Smart Driver course is available online and in a classroom setting. The class covers everything from understanding new car technologies to handling left turns and maintaining proper distances behind cars (with age, we become less effective at estimating the size of the gap between vehicles). AAA offers RoadWise Driver, a defensive driving course for people age 55 and over, and many states, such as California and Virginia, offer courses as well. Need incentive? States often allow or even require insurance companies to give an auto insurance discount to people aged 55-plus who take driver safety courses.

Talk to your doctor about medications and driving. A key topic discussed in driving courses: medications. In the AAA Foundation's "Long Road" study, one in five drivers aged 65-plus took medications that could impair their driving abilities. Fifty percent of participants were taking seven or more medications.

"Some older drivers think, 'Oh, if a medication is prescribed, or if it's over the counter, I can legally drive after taking it," Van Tassell says. Guess again. If you're swerving or you get in an accident, "The law doesn't care where it came from or how you got the drug," he says. Older people are also twice as likely to experience side effects compared to younger people, he adds. Hire a pro. If you want in-the-

vehicle, behind-the-wheel guidance, book time with an instructor from a driving school. Yes, you've got enough experience to be a teacher, not a student. But an instructor can help identify bad habits and address nagging concerns you may not even realize"It's not a bad idea," Van Tassel says, "to get some objective feedback."

"We were fortunate enough to be able to use our criminal forfeiture fund to purchase the boat and trailer so that no taxpayer funds were used," police said.

After they got the boat, the Barnegat Department of Public Works outfitted all the electronics and affixed decals in only a few days, police said.

"A huge thanks to Derek Kadlubowski, Mike Kadlubowski, Steve Bertram, Charlie Coopey and Foreman Scott Docherty," police said. "Thanks to their team, we were able to have the vessel put into service just in time for the busy summer season."

Life Jackets: Always wear a properly fitting life jacket, regardless of swimming ability or the type of vessel.

Weather: Monitor weather conditions before and during your outing, as conditions can change rapidly.

Safe Speed: Adhere to speed limits and be mindful of your surroundings, including other boaters and potential hazards. Respect all areas marked as No-Wake Zones.

BUI (Boating Under the Influence): Never operate a boat under the influence of alcohol or drugs.

Designated Skipper: If alcohol is involved, ensure a sober and qualified individual is operating the vessel.

Equipment Check: Before heading out, inspect all required safety equipment, including life jackets, flares, and fire extinguishers.

Engine Cut-off Switch: Utilize the engine cutoff switch to stop the engine if the operator falls overboard.

Communication: Maintain communication with others and let them know your location and expected

return time.

Respect the Water: Be aware of your surroundings,

navigational aids, and other boaters.
