## Project Home Repair Expands Impact Across Ocean County

Project Home Repair is a community-driven initiative focused on restoring safety, stability, and dignity for homeowners in need across Ocean County. By uniting local nonprofits and service organizations, the program tackles urgent home repair challenges faced by seniors, veterans, and vulnerable residents.

Launched in July 2023 through the efforts of Causeway CAREs, Project Home Repair has quickly become a vital resource in the region. The initiative brings together partners such as Northern Ocean Habitat for Humanity, Homes for All, Southern Ocean Habitat for Humanity, and Starve Poverty International, all working

collaboratively to meet the growing demand for essential repairs and accessibility improvements. Since its launch, Project Home Repair has completed 34 critical home repairs totaling more than \$331,000 in support for local families and homeowners.

Founded by Dave C. Wintrode, President of the Causeway Family of Dealerships and Causeway CAREs, the coalition was created to close critical gaps in support services—ensuring that individuals living in difficult conditions have access to safe, secure, and livable homes.

Over the past year, Project Home Repair has continued to make a meaningful impact across Ocean County, transforming houses into safer, more stable homes through a series of critical repair projects. Thanks to the collaboration between nonprofit partners and the dedication of volunteers, families facing difficult circumstances have been able to remain in the homes they love.

One recent project in Forked River highlights just how impactful this work can be. A local mother of two had been living with a roof more than 25 years old that was actively leaking into the attic. The condition of the roof not only threatened the safety of her home but also drove up her homeowner's insurance costs.

After reaching out to Starve Poverty for help, Project Home Repair stepped in to provide nearly \$24,000 in funding to support a full roof replacement. Completed in April 2026, the project addressed extensive rot and structural issues caused by years of wear and multiple home additions, restoring both safety and peace of mind for the family.

In Barnegat, a longtime couple has worked alongside Starve Poverty on multiple repairs over the years, demonstrating how these projects often evolve into ongoing relationships. After first receiving help with roof repairs, they later sought assistance with a deteriorating kitchen floor. Volunteers stepped in to replace the subfloor and install new flooring ahead of Thanksgiving 2025. When another issue arose in their hallway just months later, the same collaborative effort ensured the repairs were completed by April 2026. Their story reflects a broader trend. Many families who come through one program, such as the food pantry, often find additional support through home repair services, creating a vital pathway to stability.

Another Barnegat homeowner initially reached out over what seemed like a minor electrical issue, but the situation quickly revealed more serious underlying problems. Water intrusion from a window and damaged exterior components had led to structural deterioration, while additional electrical

concerns needed to be addressed before a new heating and cooling system could be installed. With materials provided by the homeowner and a team of dedicated volunteers completing the work, repairs included window replacement, structural restoration, electrical fixes, and exterior improvements. By the project's completion, the home was not only safer but ready for critical system upgrades that will improve year round comfort.

Homes for All also completed a life changing project for Joanne and Stephen, who have spent more than 40 years in their Lanoka Harbor home. As both undergo cancer treatments, the financial

strain of medical bills left them increasingly concerned about worsening roof leaks and the possibility of losing their home. Through Project Home Repair, their roof was fully replaced, eliminating the immediate risk and allowing them to focus on their health without the constant fear of displacement. "The team was amazing," shared Joanne. "We were worried we might lose our home, but now we feel safe and protected. It's hard to describe how much this means to us, especially while focusing on our health. Thank you for giving us hope and keeping us in the home we love."

Northern Ocean Habitat for Humanity has also played a key role in delivering comprehensive repairs for local residents. In Pine Ridge South, Gail and her son Donald

received critical upgrades that included a new roof, window replacements, updated flooring, and ceiling repairs. These improvements not only stabilized the home but also enhanced Donald's health by removing old carpeting that aggravated his asthma. For Gail, the repairs brought relief from the fear of structural failure and allowed them to continue living together comfortably.

In another project, Geraldine, who has lived in her Pine Ridge at Crestwood home since 1999, received essential accessibility upgrades that will help her safely age in place. Improvements included a tub to shower conversion, new steps, window replacements, and other critical repairs. With a strong support system of family nearby, these updates ensure she can continue to live independently while enjoying the comfort and familiarity of her home.

Each of these stories reflect the core mission of Project Home Repair, bringing together resources, expertise, and compassion to meet the growing need for critical home repairs in Ocean County. Through strong partnerships and community support, the program continues to change lives, one home at a time.

# Right on Target: The Journey of Bernadette Diab

Bernadette Diab is a business owner, Causeway customer, mother, grandmother, and accomplished competitive archer with an international presence.

She was first introduced to Causeway owner Dave Wintrode through mutual friends, and over time, that connection grew both personally and professionally. As the owner of her own landscaping business, Bernadette has worked with Dave and the Causeway team, bringing her expertise and attention to detail to projects they have trusted her with. In addition to her professional relationship, Bernadette is also a proud Causeway customer.

But beyond her work and local ties, Bernadette has built an impressive and unexpected path in the world of archery. It all began with a simple desire to spend more time outdoors.

Originally hunting with a shotgun, Bernadette spent a couple of seasons pursuing deer before discovering something that changed her direction. She realized that archers are able to get into the field earlier, giving them the first opportunity at some of the best bucks before gun season opens.

Wanting an early shot at the best bucks, Bernadette turned to archery. She began hunting around 2000 and transitioned into bow hunting in 2002, and what started as an advantage quickly became something much greater.

While practicing at A&M Archery in Lakewood, the owner, Mike, recognized her natural talent early on. Within her first year of learning, Bernadette entered a competition and won.

Many archers begin the sport at a young age, with the most competitive circuits typically dominated by athletes between 19 and 30 years old. Bernadette, however, carved out her own path, proving that dedication and passion can take you just as far.



Over the years, she has become a member of the World Archery Federation and has competed on an international level. Bernadette has participated in four World Cups and has been ranked 152nd in the world across all age groups. In 2017, at the age of 57, she achieved an incredible milestone by becoming a USA Pro.

Her journey has taken her to more than 15 countries, including Thailand, Morocco, Iceland, and Croatia, where she has competed against top talent while building friendships with people from around the world. Today, she continues to excel, currently ranked third in the United States in the Women's 50-plus division.

Bernadette is also a member of the Garden State Archers and competes outdoors in all conditions, demonstrating both skill and resilience. Her bow, with a 45 pound draw, requires strength, control, and precision. Her accomplishments extend beyond competition. Through her dedication, she earned a trip to Wyoming, where she successfully hunted antelope, taking down a large male from 26 yards away, a moment that reflects both patience and accuracy.



Looking ahead, Bernadette will be traveling to Utah this month to compete in the USA Team Trials, continuing to push herself at the highest level.

For Bernadette, archery is more than a sport. It has strengthened her hand eye coordination, introduced her to people across the globe, and become a lifelong passion.

Her journey is a powerful reminder that it is never too late to try something new and that sometimes the most unexpected paths can lead to extraordinary achievements.

# Ocean County College Introduces Pathways to Simplify the Student Journey and Strengthen Career Connections

TOMS RIVER, NJ – Beginning in Fall 2026, Ocean County College (OCC) will launch the Pathways model, a redesigned academic framework that reimagines how students explore programs, select courses and connect their education for future success. Grounded in the nationally recognized Guided Pathways model, the initiative is designed to provide students with greater clarity, structure and support from their first semester through graduation.

Pathways represents a significant step in OCC’s ongoing commitment to student success. Under the new framework, all degree and certificate programs will be organized into nine areas of study, making it easier for students to explore academic interests, choose a direction and stay on track toward completing their degree.

For many students, selecting a major and navigating course requirements can feel overwhelming, the Pathways model simplifies that process by providing a clear starting point and a structured roadmap that connects academic choices with transfer opportunities and career outcomes. “Ocean County College is committed to creating an educational experience that supports students every step of the way,” said Dr. Pamela Monaco, President of Ocean County College. “Pathways will help students explore their options while providing the structure and guidance they need to move forward with confidence.”

Through this redesigned framework, students will begin their academic journey within one of nine areas of study: Business; Behavioral Science and Public Service; Science; Computer Science; Math and Pre-Engineering; Health Sciences; Humanities and Cultures; Media, Communication and Design; and Fine and Performing Arts. These broad academic groupings allow students to start within a field that reflects their interests while maintaining flexibility as they refine their academic goals.

Within each area of study, students will begin with a common first term, a carefully designed first-semester experience that allows them to explore related disciplines while completing courses that apply across multiple majors. This approach ensures that exploration does not delay progress toward graduation.

As students advance in their studies, they will also have access to defined concentrations within degree programs that align with transfer institutions and high-demand career pathways. These concentrations provide focused academic direction while maintaining adaptability within each area of study.



Pathways also incorporates several best practices associated with the Guided Pathways model, including curriculum maps that outline clear course sequences, proactive advising structures that support students throughout their academic journey and ongoing data-informed improvements to strengthen outcomes.

While the model reorganizes academic offerings into a more streamlined framework, college leadership emphasize that the initiative represents much more than a structural change. “This is about improving the student experience,” said James Marshall, Executive Director of Curriculum and Academic Assessment. “By reducing confusion, minimizing unnecessary credits and strengthening connections between education and career goals, Pathways helps students stay focused on achieving their academic and professional aspirations.”

OCC will continue sharing information about the new Pathways framework with students, families and guidance counselors as the Fall 2026 launch approaches. 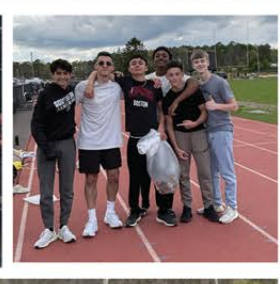

We always make sure to wash our hands well after picking them up. Once we find them, we carefully carry them across the street and release them into the canals that lead back to the bay.

I truly hope this becomes part of our experience every spring because we have so enjoyed helping these little diamondback terrapins make their way home.
